In the 2017 2nd Round of grantmaking, the Trust awarded Indianapolis OASIS \$75,000 for the Intergenerational Hi-Impact Tutoring program, which pairs senior volunteers with K-3 students in Marion County schools to receive one-on-one, individualized attention in literacy development. This program brings life altering educational impact to children struggling with reading comprehension and academic advancement.
